


Working on the front of the cow:

- 1) Fold along all of the dotted lines.
- 2) Glue or tape the tabs behind parts (a) and (b).
- 3) Cut along the short black lines, fold the paper over the grey triangles and secure.
- 4) Connect the back and front of the cow. Line the front legs up with the purple lines on the underside of the cow, and secure.
- 5) Secure the gap between the front of the cow, and at the edges represented by the purple lines. There should be a small hole still where the head will fit, but the front of the cow should be closed up. There may also be a gap under the cow towards the front but that is okay as well.
- 6) Once the body of the cow is completed, connect the head of the cow (pg 5) to the front using the tabs on the side of the head. There will be a gap under the head, but that should be okay.



For the hooves, wrap the ends around each other (using a pencil helps with this) and place the "legs" inside of the hooves. The dark grey should be facing the front of the leg. Secure with glue or tape. You may need to cut and adjust your hoof to fit into the leg properly.



Place the cow under the barn awning, and you're done!

By now, you probably are screaming about this cow, and I understand. It was probably a little more complicated than it needed to be. So much for this project being easy.
