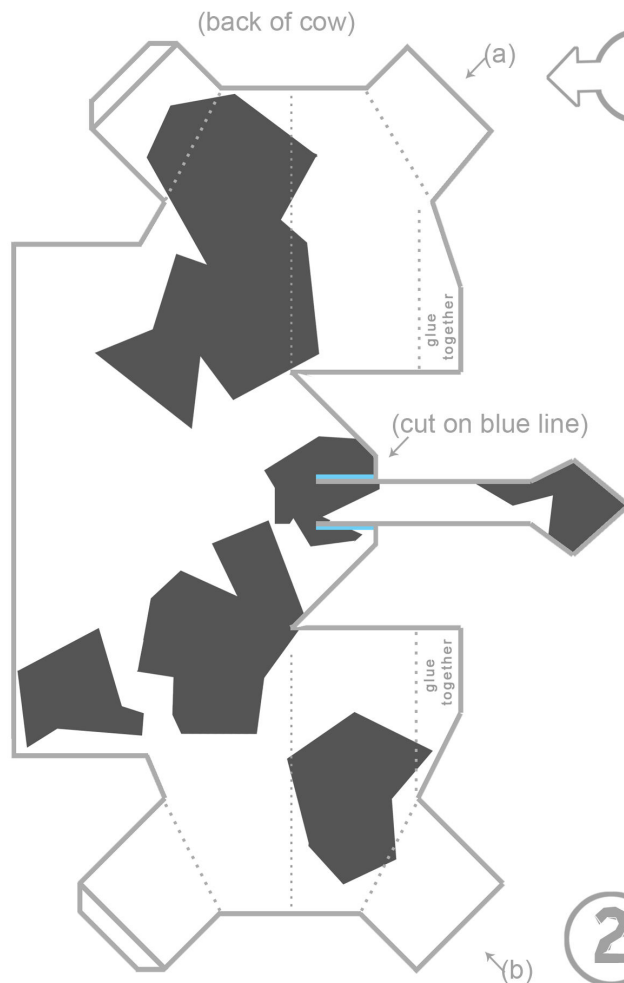

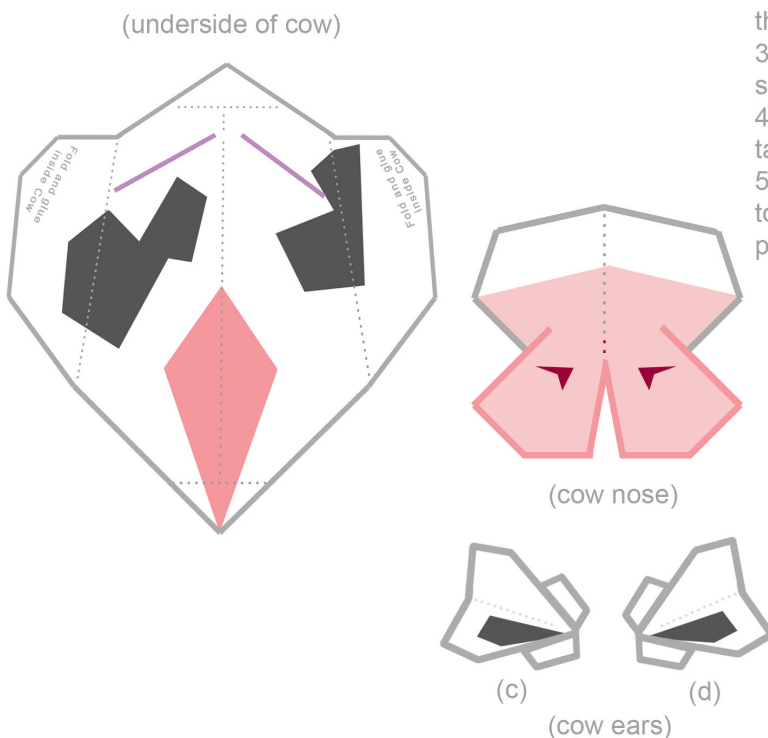
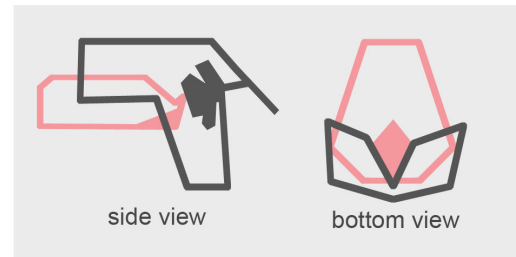

Now to begin working on the cow. Start with the back of the cow.

- 1) Fold along all of the dotted lines.
- 2) Glue or tape the tabs behind parts (a) and (b).
- 3) Cut along the light blue lines, and glue the two pieces behind the cow's tail (covering up the blue at least)
- 4) Fold the legs over, and tape or temporarily hold the "glue together" area together to see how it will align with the underside of the cow.
- 5) Fold the Underside of the Cow on all of its dotted lines.
- 6) Align the udder (pink) section under the legs and attach the folded sections to the inside of the back of the cow.
- 7) Secure the "glue together section of the legs.

The cow should look like the following at this point:



- 1) Cut out the face and secure the tabs (1) under the face first.
- 2) Cut along the solid black lines, and fold and glue the paper over the grey triangles on the sides and on the dotted lines at the back of the head.
- 3) fold the mouth sections in at the dotted lines and secure from the inside.
- 4) Cut the pink lines on the top of the head, insert the tabs from the ears, and secure underneath the face.
- 5) Cut nose at pink lines, tape middle section together, and then secure sides to the edge of the pink. Secure nose to the front of cow's face.
