

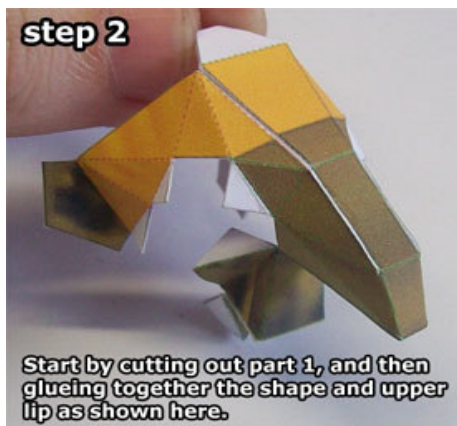
Koume & Kotake papercraft instructions

step 1



To make this paper model, all you really need are the parts, a knife, and glue. A toothpick is also a very cheap and useful tool, and a cutting mat will make your tabletop last longer. :o)

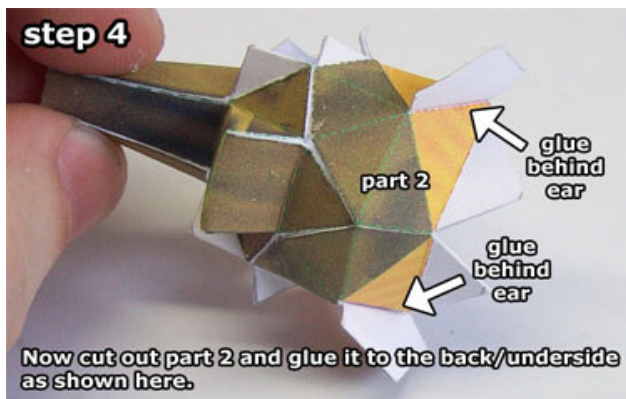

To assemble the hair, start by folding and glueing together part 20...

step 15



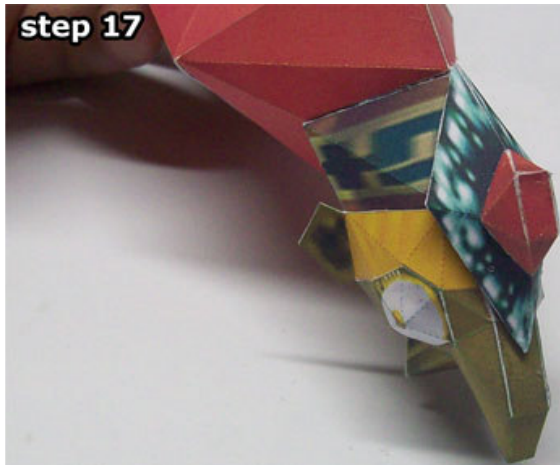
...then glue on parts 21 and 22, and glue it all on top of the head like so.

step 16



Assemble and glue together parts 23 and 24...

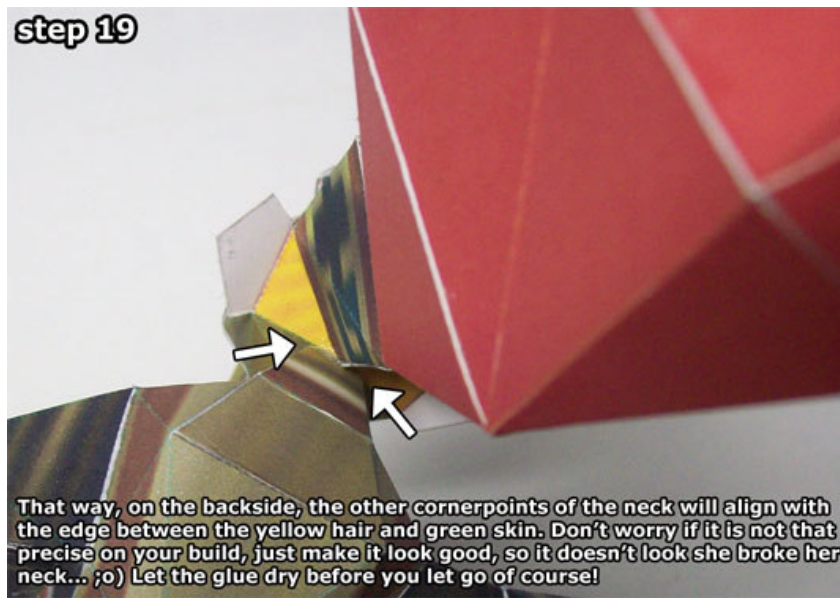
...and then glue it to the forehead. It should lay flat against the head, so gently press the parts together until the glue dries and the gem won't come loose anymore.

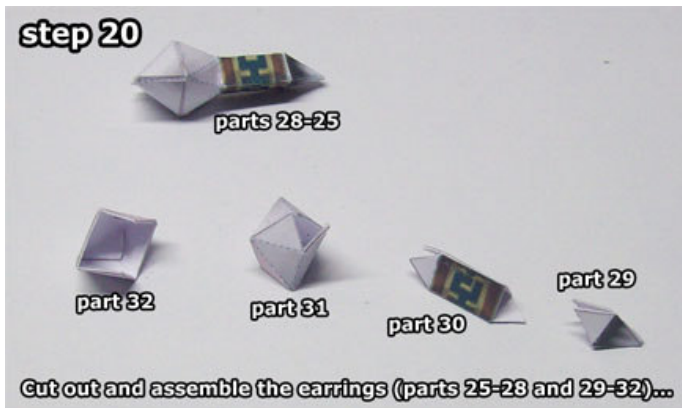


Now you need to glue the head (or one of the "normal" replacement heads from www.kickme.to/ninjatoes!) to the neck. Use the point of part 1 as alignment.

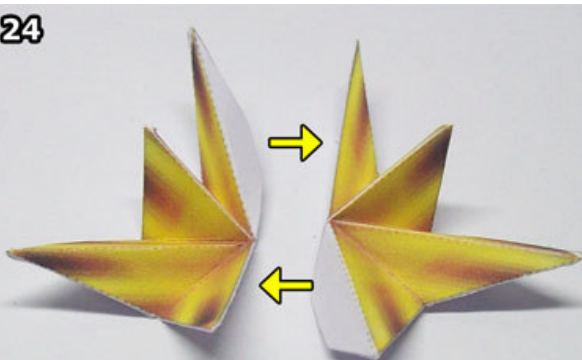

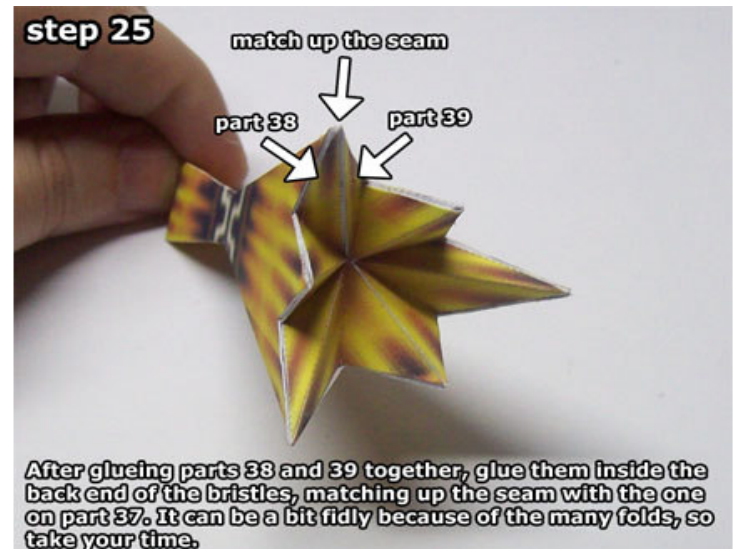

To glue on the inside of the bristles, it is very important that you fold parts 38 and 39 correctly: it is kinda like a harmonica, so the first fold is a mountain fold (up), and the next a valley fold (down), then a mountain fold again (up), and then down again and so on.

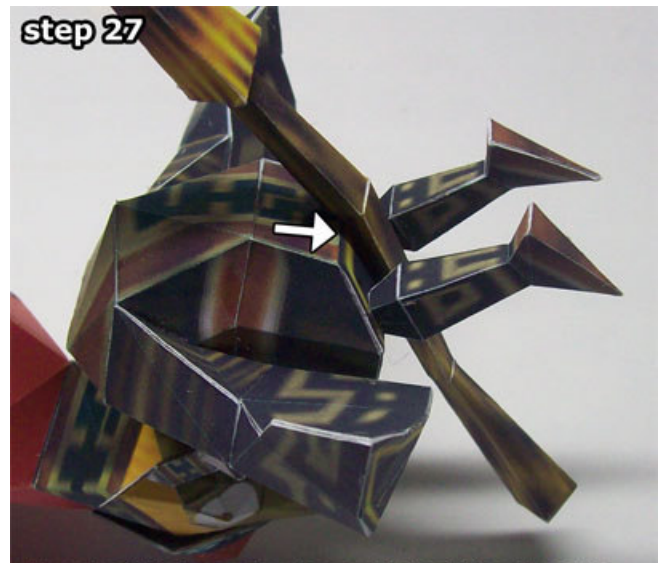

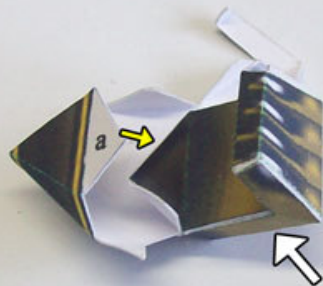
Glue the bristles and the broomstick of the broom ("besom") together with the seam on top.

step 27



Now glue it between the legs, onto the little slit on the bottom of the body (with the seam on the besom on top!)

To assemble the right hand, first score and fold/pre-shape part 40, and then glue together one side of the hand first as shown here.

Then glue together the glueing tab and edge marked "a" as indicated on the template...

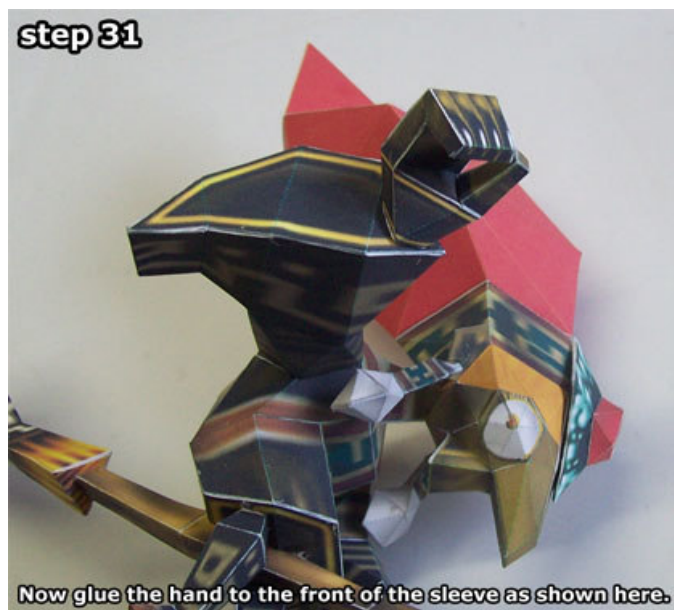
...and then glue together the other side of the hand, automatically glueing together the glueing tab and edge marked "b".

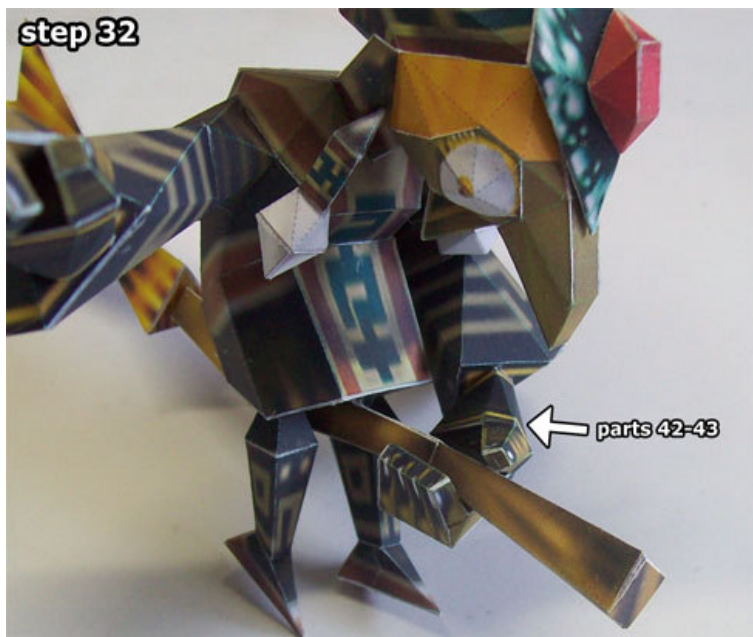
Now simply assemble the thumb (part 41) and glue it to the hand like so.

Now glue the hand to the front of the sleeve as shown here.

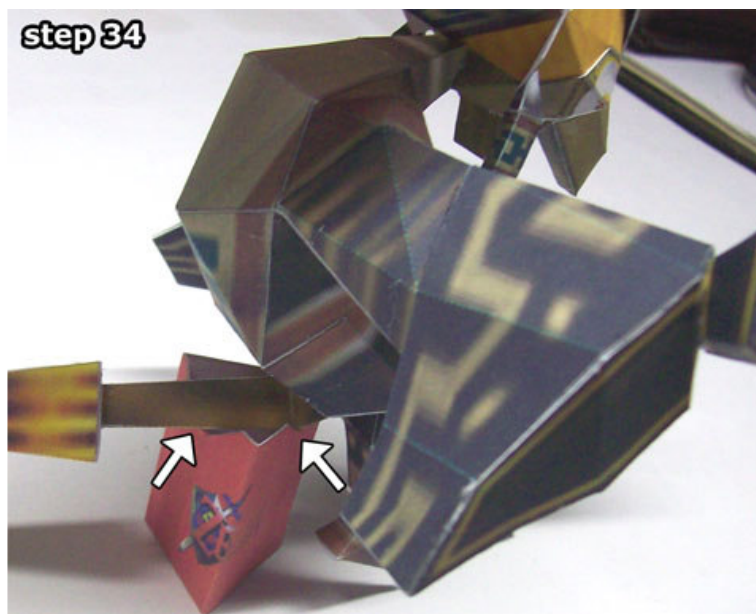
Now do the same for the left hand (parts 42-43) and if all is well, you should be able to glue it to the sleeve in such a way that she can hold the broomstick as shown here.

It's a nice effect if you hang Koume and Kotake from the ceiling using a piece of string, but you can also use this simple stand (part 44)...

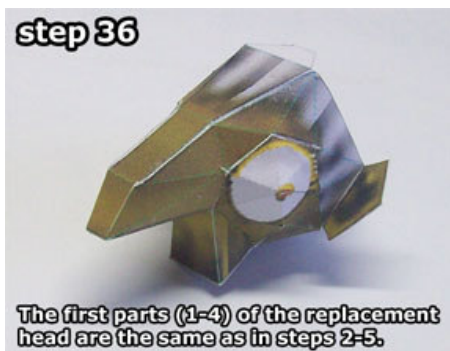
...to balance them on as shown here.

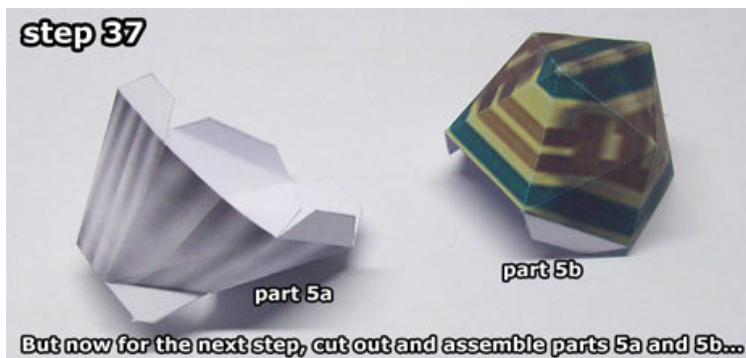

The first parts (1-4) of the replacement head are the same as in steps 2-5.

step 37



But now for the next step, cut out and assemble parts 5a and 5b...

step 38



...and then glue them to the rest of the head as shown here.

step 39



Then glue together the gem (parts 23-24) and the earrings (parts 25-28 and 29-32) as in steps 16-21...

step 40



...which will also show you how to glue the head to the neck. Thank you for building a Ninjatoes' replacement head, I hope you had fun building!
