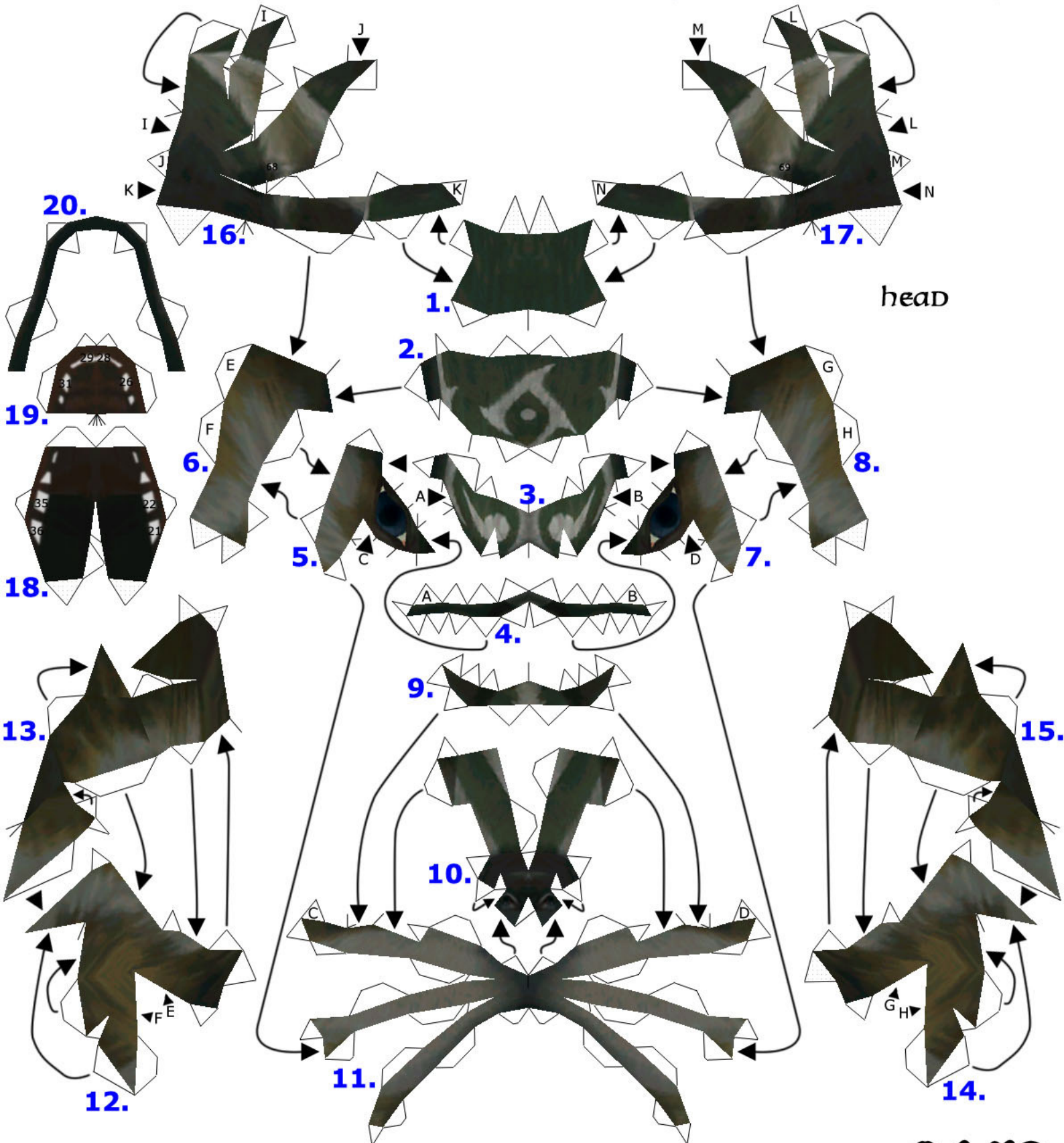


Wolf Link
