And of course, what enemy wouldn't be afraid of Big Bad Wolf Link...

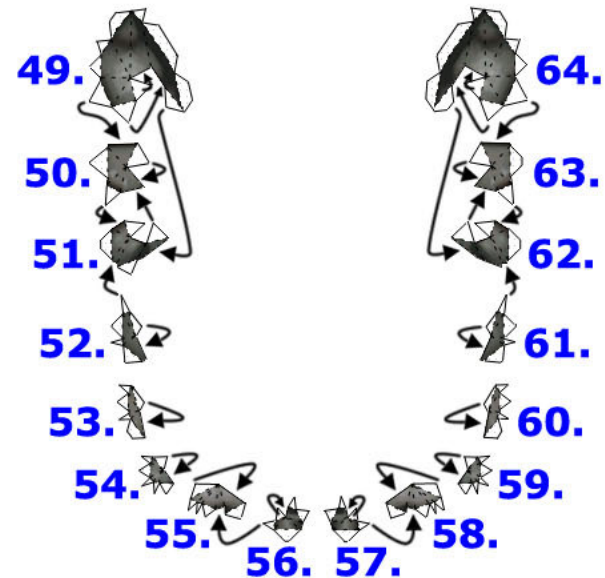
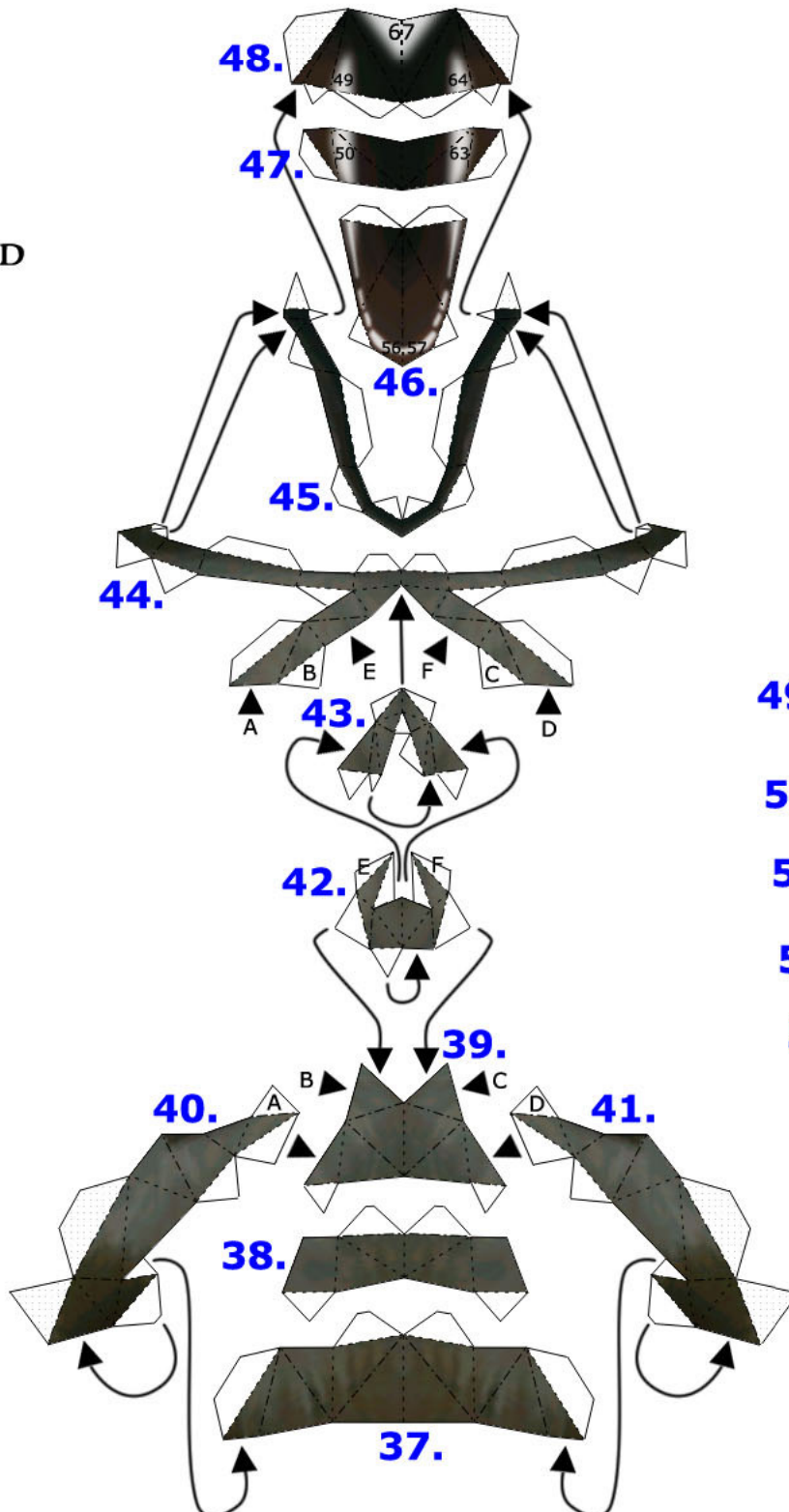
