## 1:1 Scale



1. Print the template on cardstock.
2. Cut out the white pieces.
3. Make a mountain fold on the dashed lines. Before folding, trace lightly along the folds with a ruler and an empty pen or dull exacto type knife for cleaner, more angular folds.
4. Glue sparingly at the flaps.
5. Assemble as indicated by the numbers.
6. For best results, build from the center out.




