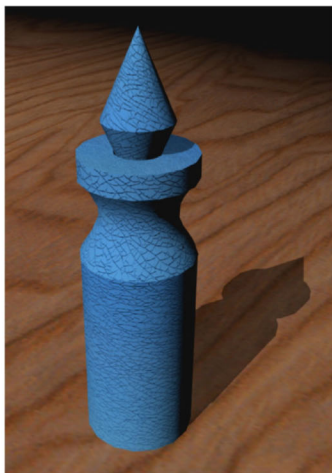


The phial of Galadriel

1:1 scale

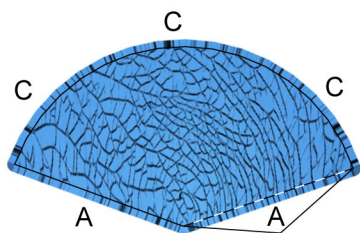


GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

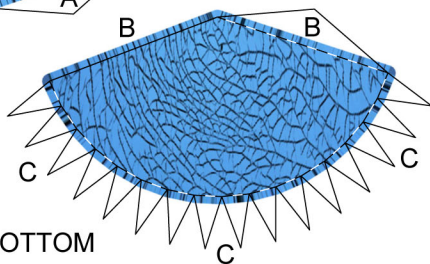
1. Print the template on cardstock.
2. Cut on the solid lines.
3. Make a mountain fold on the dashed lines.
4. Make a valley fold on the dash-dot lines.
5. Before folding, trace lightly along the folds with a ruler and an empty pen or dull exacto type knife for cleaner, more angular folds.
6. Glue sparingly at the white flaps.
7. Assemble as indicated by the letters.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

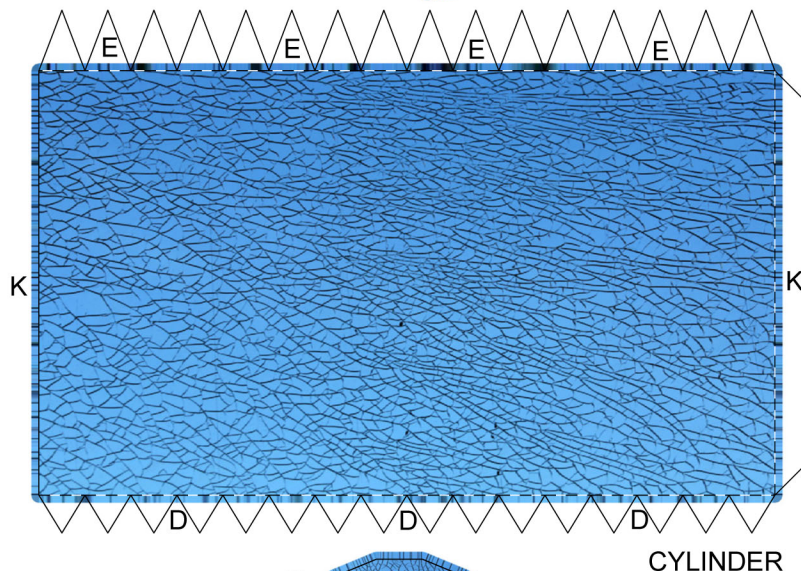
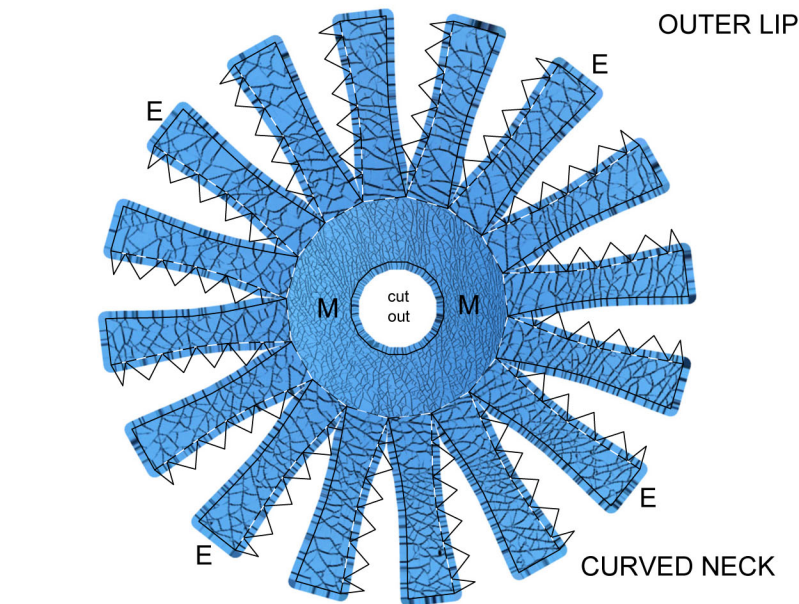
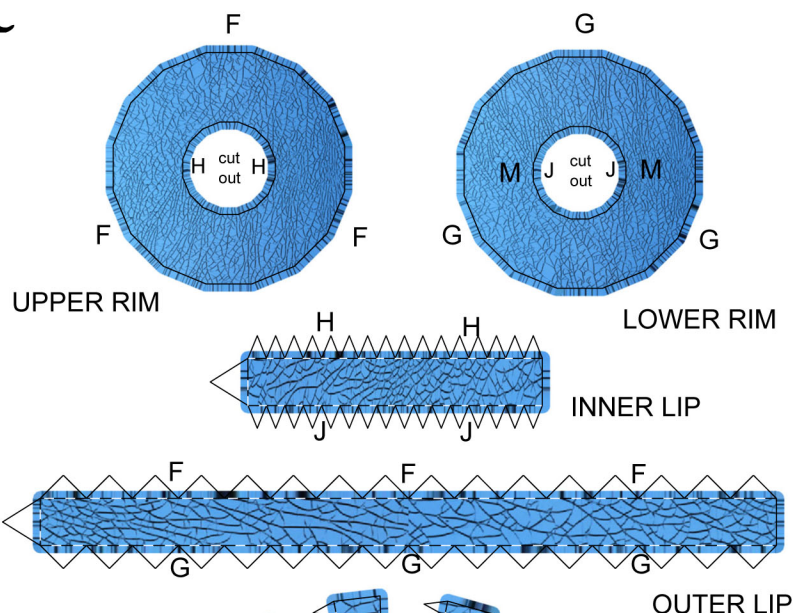
1. For best results, gently roll the cylinder, inner lip and outer lip pieces around a cylindrical object before gluing (a round exacto blade handle works well)
2. Make sure the lower rim piece is glued in place with the color side facing out.
3. Make sure the inner lip piece is glued to itself with the color side facing inward.
4. Gluing the cap to the phial is optional.



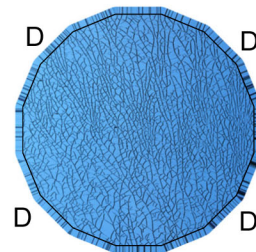
CAP TOP
