



# polar bears holiday ornament

## Materials and Tools

- 2 sheets of white cardstock or thick white paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Hole punch
- 1 foot of thin ribbon



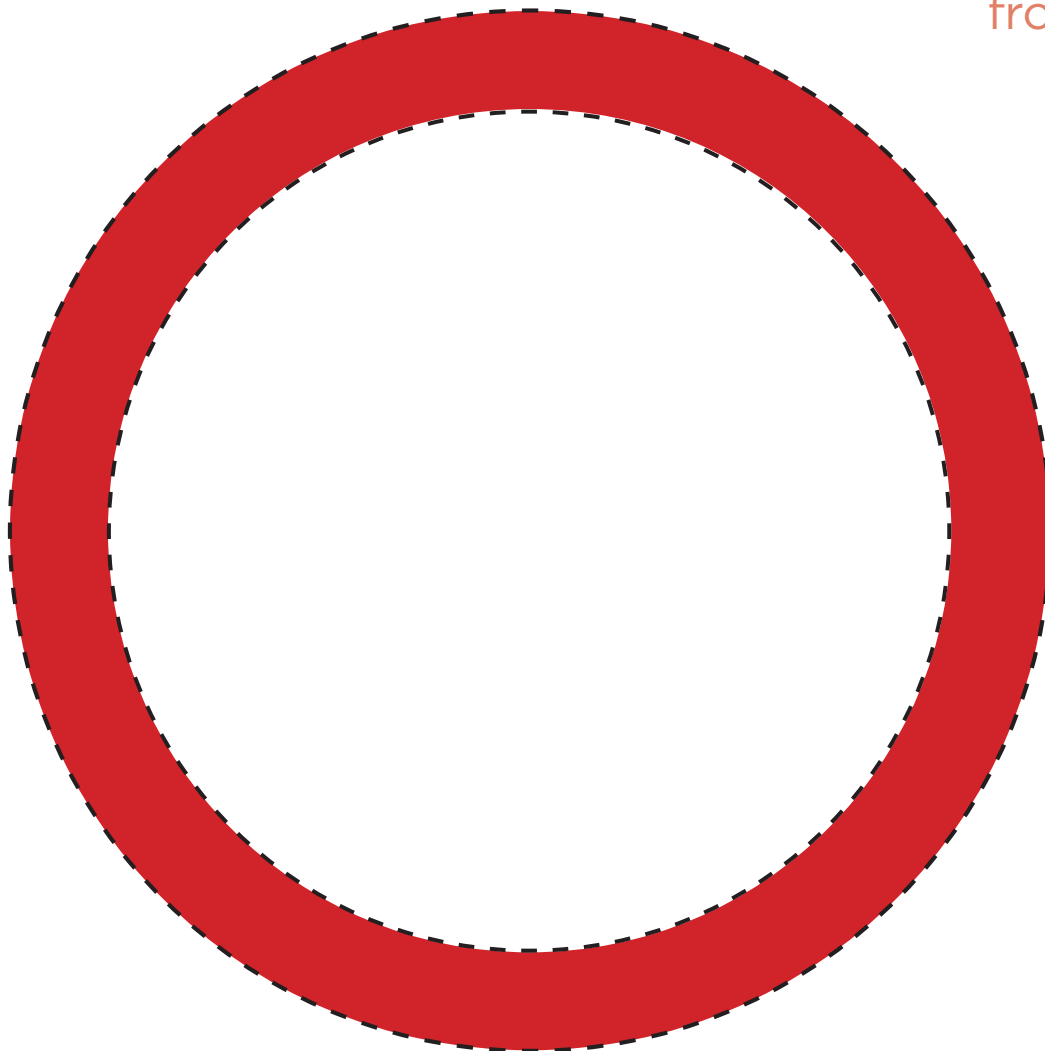
## Instructions

1. Using a color printer, print the front and back side of the ornament on white cardstock (or thick white paper).
2. Using scissors, cut the ornament out by cutting along the dotted lines. You should end up with four separate pieces: two red rings and two graphic inner circles.
3. Lightly line the unprinted side of the inner circles with glue. Sandwich one end of the ribbon between the circles, with the loose part coming out of the top end of the ornament (the top end being the end with the Coca-Cola logos on it). Be sure that the two Coca-Cola logos are lined up. Allow time for the glue to fully dry.
4. Lightly line the unprinted side of the red rings with glue. Press the unprinted sides together, gluing them in place. Allow time for the glue to fully dry. Using a hole puncher, punch a hole in the red ring.
5. Take the ribbon that is sandwiched between the inner circles and run the loose part through the hole in the red ring. Tie a small knot in the ribbon, about  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch away from the red ring (toward the loose end).
6. You should end up with an ornament where the graphic inner circle hangs, suspended inside of the outer red ring.
