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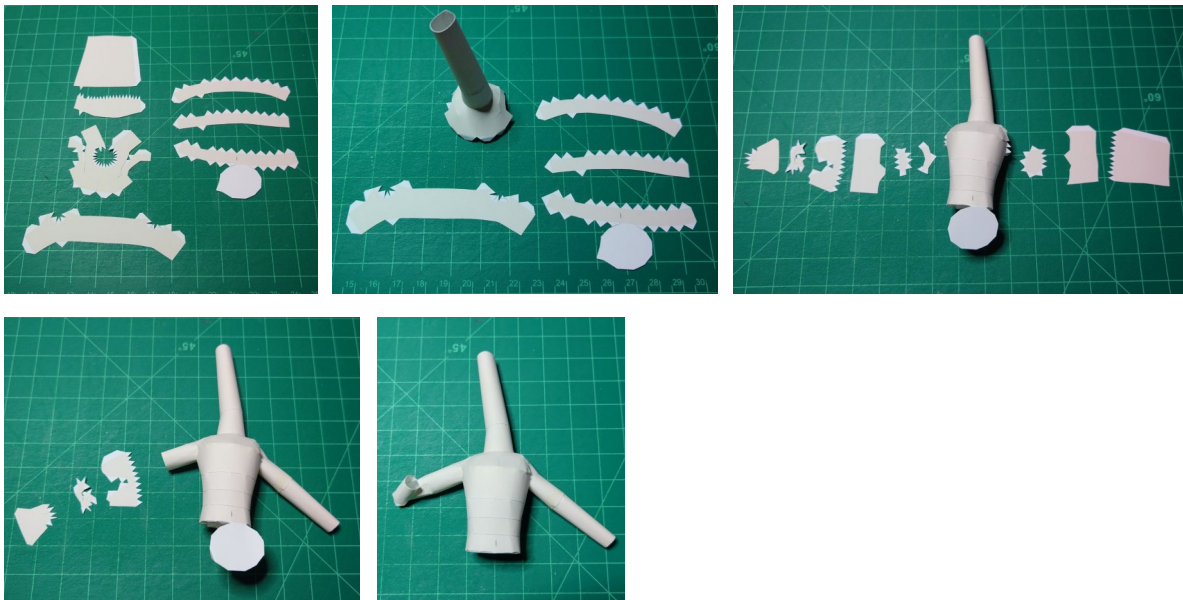

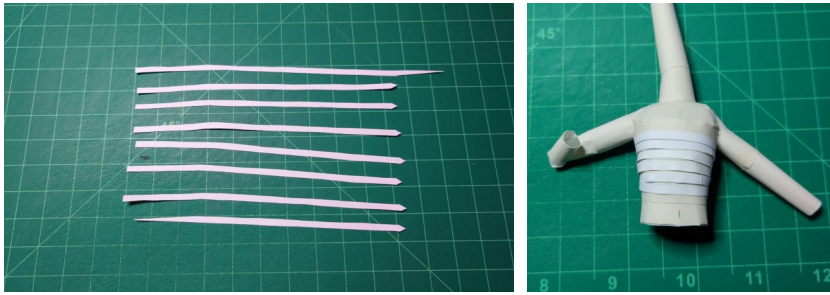

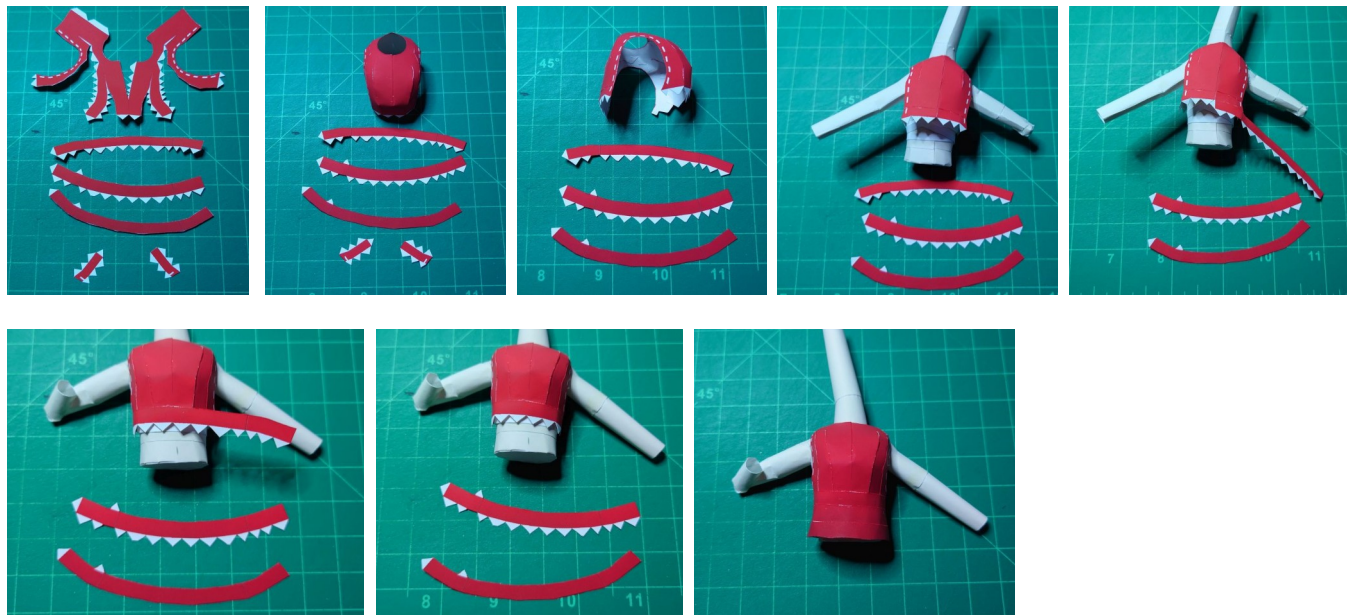
- Row 1:** Shows the initial cutting of purple paper into various shapes, including long strips and pointed pieces. A 45-degree angle is marked in the third photo.

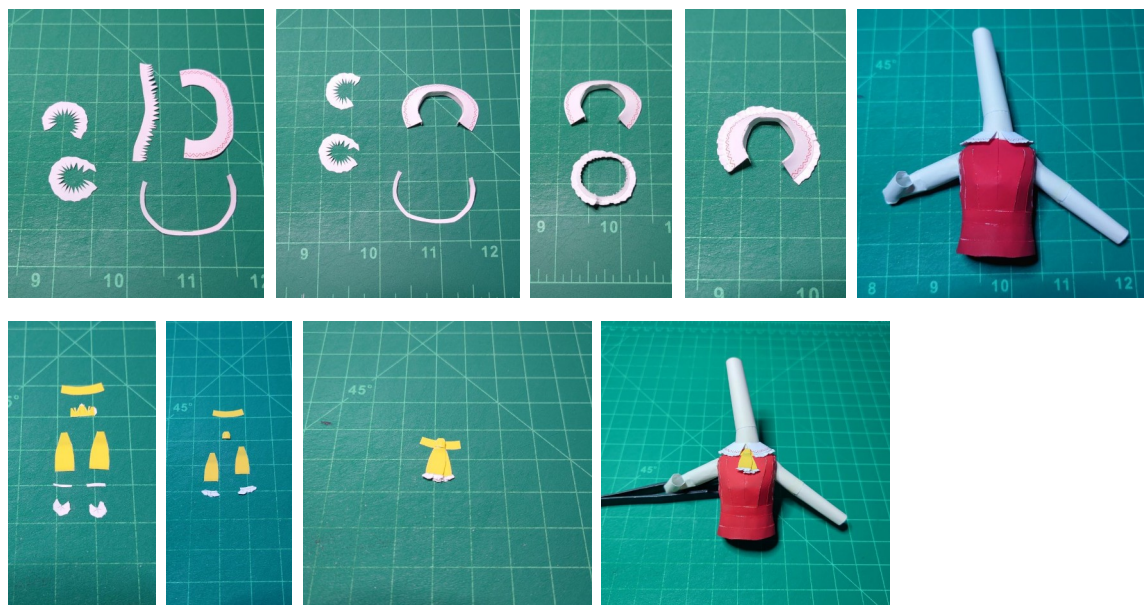


Wrap each strand around the chest until the front and sides are covered.

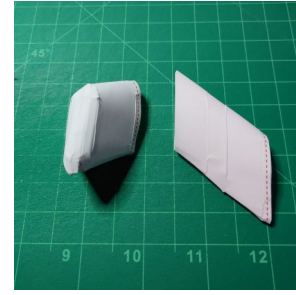
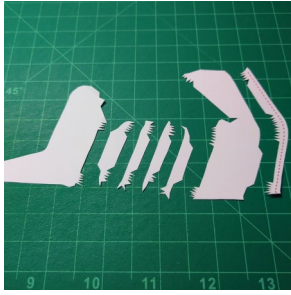

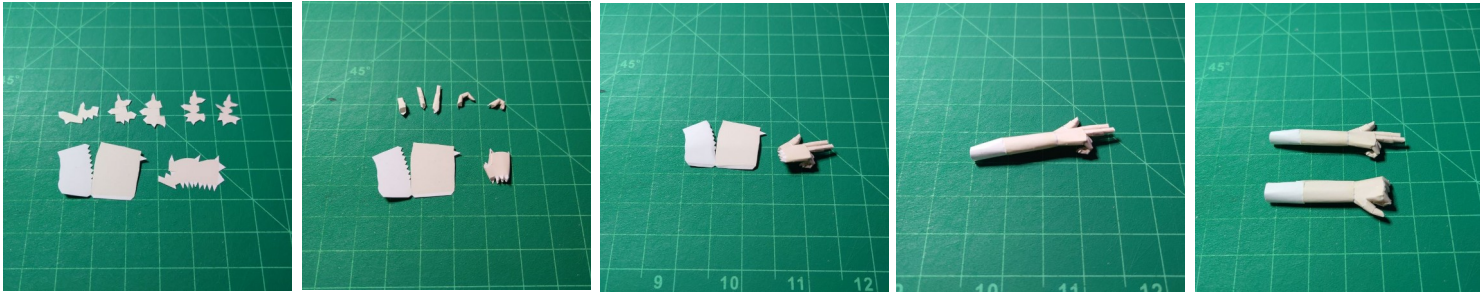

Gohei and Ofuda



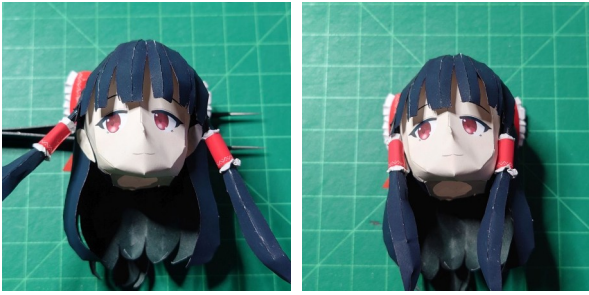
- There are two versions of paper streamers for the gohei, the folded one (pictured) and a flat version, choose the one you prefer.

Stand



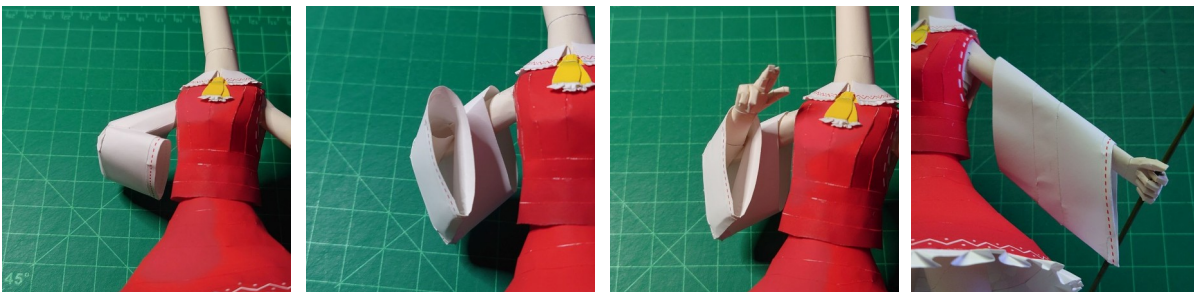
Complete Assembly



Align the head with the hair and glue the back of the ears to the hair and then glue the tubs to the side.



Insert the upper body into the skirt like in the second picture, then once you have attached the upper and lower body together, pull the skirt down.



Insert the right sleeve at an angle, then rotate it forward.
